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JOIN THE SEELOS GUILD

1. He shares in one Holy Mass offered each week before the tomb of Father Seelos.
2. He shares in prayers said daily by more than 8,000 Redemptorists.

4. He will undoubtedly be blessed by Almighty God for his efforts to further the canonization of so holy a man.

Seelos -

Apostle of Kindness

After he completed his theological courses at Munich, Xavier went to the diocesan seminary in Dillingen to wait for admission to the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. He remained in the house of the Redemptorists in Altoetting until February 1843. He and a few other Redemptorists were ordered to Baltimore in the United States.

Francis Xavier Seelos began the practice he was to preserve his life through. He did not like goodbyes. He decided to leave without returning home to his beloved family for the last farewells which would be so painful to all of them. Instead he wrote them a letter rich in love and understanding. "How happy," he said, "our next meeting will be in heaven. In spite of our physical separation by the miles between us, our love for each other remains. Love has bound us together for time and eternity."

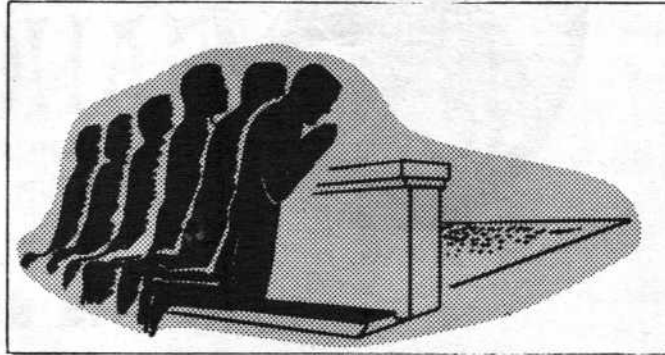
In America, Francis Xavier Seelos became Frater Seelos, the first novice of the Redemptorists to have a regular novitiate. In Baltimore God placed him under the guidance of the priest who was to be later Bishop, and then beatified, Father John Neumann. Four priests had had a novitiate of sorts before Frater Seelos, but he was to be the first to have a full novitiate. The Redemptorists lived together in peace and harmony. The poverty they suffered only made them work more joyfully together.

Frater Seelos prayed to his Lord and his beloved Virgin Mother for perseverance, obedience and chastity. He was quick to take every opportunity for the lowest tasks or the most difficult. While he schooled his keen intelligence to the humility demanded by the vows of his order, he schooled his body in the mortifications he undertook with the consent of his Superior. Every suffering he could offer up he used so gladly that his Superior was dismayed to note that there was little in the Novice Seelos to correct.

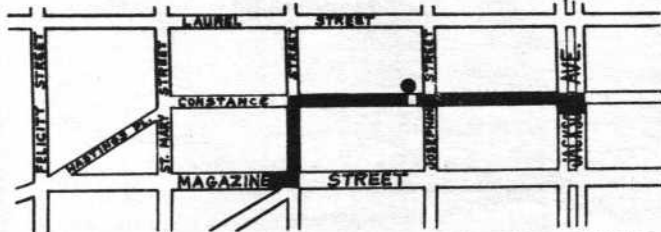
On May 16, 1844, Novice Seelos took his

vows to formally enter the Redemptorist Congregation. On December 22, 1844, he became Father Francis Xavier Seelos, C. SS. R. Shortly after his ordination, he was made assistant to the Novice Master. Here he was to stay only a short time. In August, 1845, he was sent to St. Philomena's Church in Pittsburgh.

"My reasons for praying to Father Seelos are manifold. In the first place, I am convinced that he is a real saint, deserving of canonization, and has enormous intercessory power with Almighty God. He has proved this to me on numerous occasions.

"He has already inspired me to pray with greater fervor and to look forward to my Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament each month. In fact, were it not for illness, it would be a joy to me to spend much more time with Jesus in this Sacrament of His great love.

"Further, I deeply admire Father Seelos' sincere humility and he may well be likened to the great St. Anthony in this regard.

"I have already interested a few people in making a Holy Hour once a month - persons outside of this parish - and shall continue to do all in my power to promote this magnificent cause for which you have worked so diligently.

"I pray to Father Seelos because I had a friend who knew him while she was with the Sisters in St. Mary's Parish. She had told me he was a 'Saint;' she was among those praying while he was dying of yellow fever."

"I pray to Father Seelos because I was impressed with the first sentence of the prayer to him.

"I have so much to be thankful for - my husband, my four children, a son-in-law - all of us living.

"I have never really asked Father Seelos for a favor. I get 'goose pimples' when I think of how many times he has helped me without my even asking! My petitions pass through my mind and I try to push them aside and pray, but somehow he answers them."

"I pray to Father Seelos because I feel if he was such a kind, understanding, loving man while here on earth - how much more so is he in heaven with our Lord and His Blessed Mother, both of whom Father Seelos loved so dearly. He has been such a comfort to me and my family, granting many favors - spiritual and material."
