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ST. FRANCIS XAVIER

St. Francis Xavier was the patron saint of Father Seelos. The young Francis Xavier was one of the early disciples of St. Ignatius Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits. Shortly after joining this burgeoning order, St. Francis went off to the mysterious East to preach the gospel of Christ to the Indians and the Japanese. He had a great desire to evangelize the people of China. Still young, his ambition not quite realized, he died on Sancian Island, in sight of one of the main ports of China.

Like his patron, Father Seelos left home early for foreign parts to bring the ministry of his priesthood to the many European immigrants to the United States. He died, relatively young, in the city of New Orleans as a direct result of ministering to the sick and dying of yellow fever.

FATHER SEELOS WAS A RECOLLECTED MAN

Father Seelos had a copy of the primitive Redemptorist Rule, which he treasured as a rich possession, which he read often to be impregnated, saturated, with the spirit of his beloved Congregation. The Rule is written along the lines of 12 designated monthly virtues. It is a very short and simple and livable Rule. There are 12 chapters of two sections each. The first section shows how Christ is the model in practicing the respective virtues. The second section is how the Redemptorist must live in imitation of Him.

The virtue for October is Recollection and Silence. St. Alphonsus points out in the Rule how our Most Holy Redeemer spent 30 of His 33 years in this world in silence. Then, how He began His public life with a long retreat of 40 days, how He often in these three years of activity went off alone to pray, and how very often He was silent on occasions, especially when accused of something and in the presence of certain people. So, St. Alphonsus wants his Redemptorists in imitation of Christ to give more time to recollection and silence than to noisy activity so as to be more effective in their missionary work.

Father Seelos used to say that silence was the easiest of all the virtues and is sinned against the most. The Bible has so many beautiful things to say about the tongue and many bad things, too.

Father Seelos looked forward to his annual retreat of ten days and to his monthly day of retreat, to be alone with Christ in the desert.

He read bits of the Gospel daily. He heard Christ speak, revealing Himself to him. He read bits of St. Paul's epistles daily to grow in love for God and the Church, after the heart of this great missionary.

He had all kinds of reminders in his room to keep him recollected. He used a favorite devotion of St. Alphonsus, "The Clock of the Passion." It goes like this: Whenever you look at the clock, you ask yourself: Where was Our Most Holy Redeemer at this particular hour during His judgment, His tortures, His carrying the Cross, on the world's first Holy Thursday night and Good Friday. Our Lord was comparatively silent in His sufferings. Father Seelos, like all holy people, suffered in silence.

He spoke to defend the absent, he was silent when the conversation became condemnatory.

He forgot about silence when he was called to some priestly, parochial or missionary work, no matter at what hour it happened to be. He was an action priest and at the same time a recollected religious.

In imitation of Father Seelos, I would suggest that you try to make an annual retreat; also, a day of recollection every month all by yourself. Don't neglect any duty or any person to do this.

Whenever you are alone, don't be silent - talk to God continuously.

Love to hear God speak - read your New Testament. Maybe you could plan to live the "Clock of the Passion of Our Lord."

The Bible tells us that our Blessed Mother spoke on just four occasions. In all, there's a time to speak and a time to be silent. Keep speaking to Jesus and Mary.
