



# I KNOW I LOVE GOD, BECAUSE I LOVE MY NEIGHBOR

*(Father Grangell's Monthly Conference)*

The virtue for the month of April: FRATERNAL CHARITY

Patron Saint: St. John the Evangelist and Apostle

Text: This is my Commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. (John 15/12)

If an angel from heaven appeared to you or to me and took us to any big city of the world, or to any small town, or along any country road, he would point out the religious atmosphere of each house, as God sees it. Here is an old home — the fourth generation is living in it. It has been a good Catholic home. There has never been a defection from the True Church in it. Each generation loved the Holy Sunday Sacrifice of the Mass — "Wonderful". Here is another home, where Catholicity has been strong for years, but now there is a High School teen-ager who quit going to Sunday Mass. He has lost his Faith. We call him a sinner — he has left his God. The house is blighted. It is not a home — "Sad". The next house is a spiritual morgue, everybody in it is dead in mortal sin — "Terrifying". The god of many houses is Sex. In most hearts there is no fear of God and all are living on the brink of eternity.

The question is: Can we do anything about all this? We must. It's the month of Fraternal Charity and we must develop the habit of praying for the conversion of sinners, not just an occasional "Our Father" and "Hail Mary", but to sit down with the good God in the Blessed Sacrament and tell Him what we want to do to save souls — All Souls! In the first place, give good example.

1. The greatest prayer of all: The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, which is of Infinite Value, praying through Christ, with Christ, in Christ. If you cannot go to daily Holy Mass, make it a mental offering several times a day: "My Good God, I offer you all the Masses which are being said ceaselessly around the world, for myself and for those who never go to Holy Mass. Give me the grace to live and to die in Sanctifying Grace which I receive in Holy Communion."
2. The Blessed Sacrament: Kneel at the Tabernacle and pray: "My Good God, I never want you to be alone day or night in this tabernacle or any tabernacle of the world". There are over three billion people in the world. I want everybody — babies just born and the old and the sick who will die within the present hour — multiplied as many times as there are tabernacles in the world. I want everybody saying ceaselessly: "My God I love you, forgive me my sins and everybody his sins". God loves the prayer of Desire. This desire embraces the whole world for God.
3. I want everybody's every breath to be: "My God I love You, forgive me my sins".
4. Dear Blessed Mother! You are the refuge of sinners; pray that all Godless people come back to God before their death and eternal judgment.

If you are the only one who comes to the Wednesday and Sunday Novenas in St. Mary's Church, for the canonization of Father Seelos, say the prayers alone, and at the end of the Holy Mass, go to the altar rail and bless yourself with the crucifix of Father Seelos and whisper your own pious prayers to the good God. Thank God you came!

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We are in the last days of Lent! Read your Crucifix as a book. Christ is on the Cross for love of me, to save my soul for a happy eternity. Until He died on the Cross, He could do just two things — suffer and pray.
