My ten-year-old daughter was diagnosed with a rare and deadly form of leukemia two days after Easter this year. A friend of ours blessed her with a first-class relic and gave her a second-class relic and a medal. Then our priest anointed her and blessed her with his first-class relic.

After she came home from the hospital, a strange thing happened. She couldn't sleep. I told her to get into bed and I would read her a story or sing to her. She climbed into bed and I went into the next room to turn off the lights. About two or three seconds after she got into bed, I heard her say, "um, excuse me, but didn't you die?" I couldn't imagine whom she was talking to. The TV was off and she wasn't in bed long enough to have gone to sleep. I was walking to her room when she came into the next room very upset. She said, "Mommy, I don't think I was asleep, but I must have been dreaming." I asked her what happened. She said, "That priest came to see me in my room." What priest, I asked. She said, "The one whose picture is hanging in the back of our church." I knew immediately that it was Blessed Seelos. She said I could get my medal; his picture is on there too. I asked what he did. She said he blessed her just like Fr. Fisher (our parish priest did) with oil. I asked why that frightened her. She looked at me and said, "Mom, he's dead isn't he? I don't want to be visited by anybody dead, not even a priest." I told her that if it was a dream, it was a good dream. "Any time a priest blesses you, it's a good thing." I said if it wasn't a dream, you don't think that he was able to sneak out of heaven, do you? God had to send him or give him permission to come so that's a good thing too. She thought about that for a minute and went back to bed and right to sleep.
