
HEALING MASS

The curious case of Carson Coyle: an update from the desk of Fr. Enderle

The Lord has blessed us with many visitors and inquiries at the Seelos Center since the November 14 airing of the **Carson Joseph Coyle** story on WWL-TV (local CBS affiliate), hosted and edited by the gracious and talented **Karen Swensen**.

The story highlighted the sudden recovery of Carson, now about one-year-old, who had suffered very serious brain damage during his difficult birthing process. One of our faithful Seelos Blessers, **Dennis Waldron**, went to the hospital, prayed over the infant Carson, and blessed him with the Seelos relic cross. Shortly afterwards there followed Carson's medically unexplainable return to health. Today, the toddler gives every evidence of seemingly normal growth and health.

As Vice-postulator of the Seelos Cause, **Fr. Gil Enderle** is currently in possession of volumes of pertinent medical records which he has the privilege of carefully examining.

I think a miracle happened when my son, Scott, recovered from a very serious brain injury. He was brutally beaten and left for dead after a home invasion and robbery. When he didn't show up for work, we went to his house and found him on the bathroom floor barely breathing. There was blood all over the living room and bathroom. We called 911 and he was placed in ICU with 5 skull fractures, bleeding on the brain, several facial fractures, a broken hand and multiple bruises. He was critical for days, as he developed blood clots and pneumonia which sent him back to ICU for a week.

Scott was anointed by a priest. We continued to pray for Scott and asked everyone we knew to pray for him. Our pastor brought us a Blessed Seelos prayer card. We prayed and prayed to him for a miracle. We feel that our prayers were answered as Scott started to come out of his drugged coma and began talking. Over the next 3 months, he went from the hospital to rehab and then home, and was able to go back to work part time.

We thank God, our parish priest, family and friends who prayed for Scott's recovery. We feel that Blessed Seelos truly interceded and gave us a miracle.

METAIRIE, LA

After a routine check-up with my physician, my lab work showed one elevated liver enzyme. A MRI showed 9-10 lesions in the liver, two lesions in the lung and a mass in the pancreas. A biopsy of one of the liver lesions confirmed a diagnosis of Stage 4 Metastatic Carcinoma. The prognosis was dismal. If left untreated, I would have 6 weeks to 3 months to live. I started chemotherapy the next day.

The details of my diagnosis spread quickly. We experienced an outpouring of prayers and support. I was given a first class relic of Blessed Seelos which I put against my chest and near my heart. Through this journey I have learned much about Blessed

Seelos and his wonderful life. We visited the Seelos Center, received a blessing, and attended a Healing Mass. Every day during prayer, I think of Blessed Seelos. I feel that he has been instrumental in helping me through his journey.

My spiritual growth has helped me while going through medical treatment. After 8 rounds of chemo, a scan showed I was in complete remission! No active cancer cells were seen in my body. It is medically unheard of to have these results. We praise God and thank Blessed Seelos for his intercession and all those who prayed for me.
