I look forward to celebrating Mass with you. This is a good way to enter even more fully into our new year of life.



Letter of December 31, 1842 to the sister of Seelos, Antonia, shortly before he left for America

Dearest Sister,

Actually, I want to write to you again for the many letters I received from you; want to thank you from the bottom of my heart for your sisterly love, want again to send you a letter, because I know it will make you happy.


Dearest sister, the year is over, an important year, for me, for you, for our whole family, because in it the ground was laid and preparations made for a new way of life, for a vocation that is calling a loving member to part his loving family. Love has united us, love does not mean parting, love will always remain, love will unite us again in the beyond.

> Parting brings us pain and sorrow. We feel it raging fiercely in our deepest soul, For flesh and blood do not like To empty the chalice of sorrow on earth, And to honor thereby the will of God. Yet, heavenly fervor steels our courage, And will also refresh the sorrowing heart, Will console the sister with joy and elation.

Yes, dearest sister, when peace and tranquility have returned to your heart; when, standing higher, you can look beyond the first agitation of the natural man; when you consider that my yearning can only find true peace in doing this, and that you yourself, once I have attained my purpose, will certainly see fulfilled my deepest longing, then your heart will only be able to express joy, and your mouth, gratitude to God.

Again, dear sister, farewell. I wish all of you a real Happy New Year. Dear mother, dear father, dear brothers and sisters - to all a very Happy New Year. God will give me that too.
