My daughter Josey Angelica was 10 months old when diagnosed with an ultra-rare kidney disease called Atypical Hemolytic Uremic Syndrome. She was rushed in an air ambulance to Children's Hospital in New Orleans and we were told her medication would likely be lifelong and that in most cases, her diagnosis is genetic. While in the hospital, our parish priest visited with some prayer cards, one of which was Blessed Seelos. After our discharge, we had to make regular visits to New Orleans for blood work. During one of our visits, I found St. Mary's Assumption close by, not even realizing that it was the Shrine of Blessed Seelos. We began visiting often and had several people pray over my sweet daughter. She has now been off her medication for almost a year and no genetic abnormalities have been found! She is a thriving, healthy, happy two year old.

There were more "coincidences" that I believe are signs from the Lord that Blessed Seelos has been interceding for us for longer than I even knew. He and my mother share a birthday, and he passed away on my birthday. He requested to be buried under the beautiful Mater Dolorosa statue - we are parishioners of Mater Dolorosa in Independence, LA. My childhood parish was St. Alphonsus Liguori, who founded the Redemptorists. To top all of this off, my mother recently sent me a picture she had taped in her laundry room cabinet. She would look at it and pray for me when I was away from the church - it was a picture of me kissing a relic of Bl. Seelos when I was a young child. Thank you for your intercession, Blessed Seelos! We feel your love and prayers!




HOT IN THE SHOP

This 384-page paperback offers daily respite for the weary caregiver, a chance


